Helpful tips for Diabetes Management- Susan Brongiel

Women consume no more than 45 Gms. Carbohydrates per meal

Men no more than 60 Gms. Carbohydrates per meal

Be active try to do at least 15-20 minutes of activity daily. (get a buddy, use fitness tracker to keep you accountable if necessary.

Avoid processed foods if possible. For snacks eat fresh veggies and snacks.

Try to keep all beverages sugar free preferably water, sparkling water, black coffee and unsweetened tea. No more than 2 diet sodas per day. Doing this helps to save your carbs for real food.

Consume 25-25 Gms. of fiber daily (this helps to process carbs more efficiently)

Normal fasting blood sugar should be 70-99 mg/dl (non-diabetes)

Good control blood sugar (fasting) 80-130 mg/dl (have diabetes)

Good control blood sugar (non-fasting) less than 160 mg/dl (have diabetes)

HbA1c prediabetes is considered 5.7%-6.4% Diabetes is anything over 6.5%


